“My paintings include experimental techniques both in acrylic and watercolor paints on paper. Subjects include both abstract and Florida themes. I continually explore the liquid nature of water-based paints that mix on the surface. Achieving interesting color effects sparks my imagination and keeps my painting fresh

I have a BA in Fine Art from Florida State University in Tallahassee, FL. I also have a Master of Social Work from FSU and worked as a Licensed Clinical Social Worker before retiring in 2000. I have studied with many fine watercolor artists at workshops and have Signature Memberships with The Georgia Watercolor Society and The Tallahassee Watercolor Society as well as memberships in the Florida Watercolor Society, Southern Watercolor Society, The International Acrylic Painters Society - Florida and Associate Membership in The American Watercolor Society.

I exhibit frequently in the Tallahassee area in watercolor shows. My work can be seen at Humidity Gallery, 1355 Market Street, Eye Associates, 2020 Fleischman Rd. and the gift shops of LeMoyne Center for the Visual Arts and Gadsden Arts Center in Quincy, FL. Two recent awards were First Place Award in the 21st Tri-State Juried Water Media Exhibition, April 2009, Tallahassee, FL and The American Frame Corp. and Strathmore Paper Co. Award at the Florida Watercolor Society 38th Annual Exhibition, September, 2009, Punta Gorda, FL. My painting “The Hay Wagon” was published in Splash 5-The Glory of Color, North Light Books Pub. Co., 1998.

I have been a member of Tallahassee Watercolor Society for about 15 years and now have life Signature Membership. I served as president from 2004 – 2006. I am currently serving as Workshop Co-Chairman.”

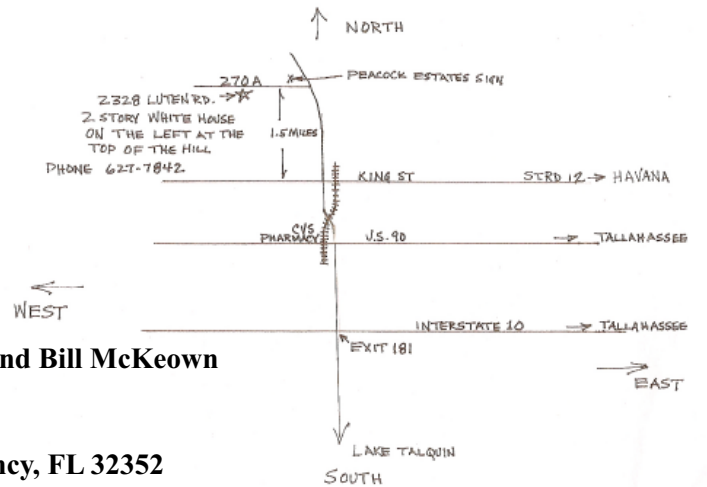

## Remember the Calendar?

Remember the calendar? That is, remember the TaWS Calendar available and accessible to all TaWS members. The calendar is to record Society events and individual members' shows, acceptances to other organization's exhibitions and, of course, placement in those exhibitions. Also you could add venues in which you will be exhibiting your work

It is easy. Go to [tallahasseewatercolorssociety.com](http://tallahasseewatercolorssociety.com) and click on calendar on the left side. The present month will appear. You can change the month or change the way you view the calendar. Your calendar could be a day, weekly and even a yearly view.

Should you want to record an event, scroll down to the bottom below the Display Boxes to Calendar: add/edit. Click on that box and you will be able to complete your entry through the format at the top which will add or edit your entries to your specific date(s). Below that is a way to repeat the entry on specified times or through a specified period of time.

Fool around! I sure do! Click on options and then settings next to the add/edit box. You will be able to customize your view of the calendar. There are different colors, fonts, displays. You can print it; you can send it out (although I have not explored this option.) When you want to return to the calendar click on the yellow box at the top left and you will return to the initial calendar. Our Ursula Jackson developed this calendar, so please check it out and add your events. It is a very informative tool for your use. ENJOY!

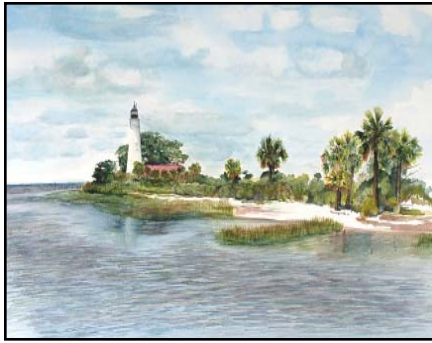
