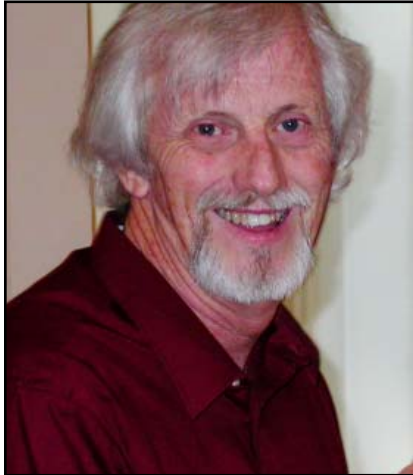

The October meeting of the Tallahassee Watercolor Society will feature a discussion and demonstration by Ken Menke on the use of triads. Attention will be given to the advantages and disadvantages of the triad approach to watercolor with examples of exercises to illustrate triad exploration. A demonstration is planned which will illustrate applications in portraiture. Attendees are invited to bring some of their favorite pigments and supplies to experiment – totally optional. Also bring questions, opinions and personal experiences to share on this topic.

Ken Menke is currently TaWS's treasurer and has actively participated in local exhibits over the past decade. In recent years he has gravitated increasingly to the limited palette approach to painting, using watercolor and occasionally acrylic.

At this October meeting Eluster Richardson will facilitate the Artist Dialogue. Bring a painting to discuss. Much is learned from these discussions.

The Brogan Museum will host an exhibition of 50 masterpieces of Italian Baroque Paintings in March –May of 2011. The Museum has extended an invitation to the Tallahassee Watercolor Society to show the paintings of members that is titled 16th Century Paintings in the Now. This exhibit will be hung in the Museum in conjunction with the main exhibition from Italy.

Images of the paintings will be available for selection by our artists only during the October 17th and/or November 21st Monthly TaWS Meetings. CoChairs Rosemary Ferguson and Esther Tubbs will be talking about this exhibit during those meetings and give the opportunity for artists to sign the Exhibit Intent forms and receive their Guidelines. TaWS member artists will be able to pick one of the 16th century images and then paint their interpretation of that work.

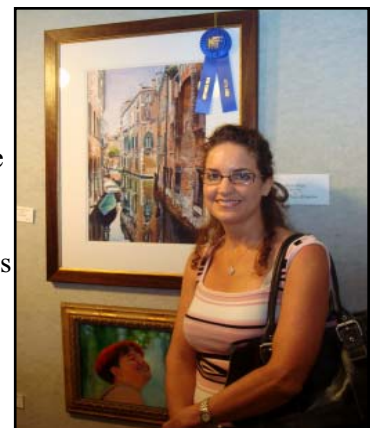

22nd Art in Gadsden Juried Exhibition of Fine Art

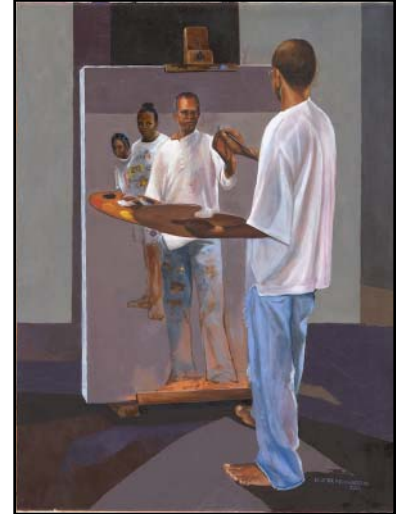
